Children with special needs

Parents are required to notify staff if their children have one-on-one support during the school year. Parents will be responsible to ensure that their child has a support worker while attending the program. If a child with a diagnosed special need attends the program without a support worker he/she may be removed from the program if the child requires extra support

Bullying Policy

The YMCA of Wood Buffalo would like to ensure that all children have a fun and safe experience. It is therefore important that we maintain a bully-free atmosphere. The YMCA of Wood Buffalo reserves the right to send a child home from the program without a refund, at anytime, or to discharge a child at anytime if there is any evidence of bullying.

Allergies, Medications and Other Special Requirements

Parents must make the YMCA aware of all special requirements for their children at the time of registration; this includes allergies, medical or behavioural concerns and or other special requirements. Parents and guardians of children requiring administration of prescription medication must complete a medication permission form.

Important things to know for Summer Programs 2011

- Children attending the program must be registered in Grades 1-6
- There is no camp Monday August 1st, 2011 due to the Civic Holiday.
- Expect a call from your child's counselor the week before camp.
- Parents, please make sure we are aware of your child's allergies and medical needs.
- In order for staff to administer any medication, a medical permission form must be completed and on file. Please ask the staff for one on site.
- We are a NUT SAFE program.
- Please send a hat, appropriate outdoor clothing, bathing suit, sunscreen (SPF 30+), bug spray, a nut-safe lunch, and a water bottle each day.
- Label all of your child's belongings. The YMCA is not responsible for lost or stolen

What Not to Bring:

The following items should stay safe at home

- Expensive or new clothes and shoes
- Toys and stuffed animals
- Hand held video games, iPods, cell phones or any other electronic device – If you need to reach your child we have a phone on site
